Overview

HBG is excited to present our ninth 3D printed set featuring the massive H-44 Class German Battleship. The rules for the 3D printed sets are identified in Global War 2nd edition as “TDP” sets, followed by a designating letter (A, B,C) etc. for reference in future rules. This set is designated as TDPI

These rules are written Global War - 2nd edition, however at the end of this document are a few changes necessary to play these with Axis and Allies 1940.

Set Contents

H-44 Battleship (x1) (3d Printed in color Black or Grey)

H-44 CLASS BATTLESHIP

The concept for the H-44 class battleship were made under Hitler’s planned expansion for the Kriegsmarine known as War Plan Z. The H-44 would have displaced 131,000 tons – more than twice that of the Japanese Battleship Yamato which was projected at “only” 69,000 tons. Capable of 30 knots and armed with 20-inch main guns, the H-44 would be a truly formidable weapon. The H-44 was also equipped with 12 5.9in (150mm) and (16) 4.1in (105mm) guns. For air defense it was equipped with (68) 20mm and 37mm AA guns. An H-44 would have been able to carry up to (9) Arado Ar-196 reconnaissance seaplanes.

Availability: July 1939

Shore Bombardment: 6

Hits: The H-44 takes 4 hits to sink. Each hit reduces the H-44 by -2 attack and defense.

Building: The H-44 must be constructed at a shipyard and takes 6 turns to complete.
